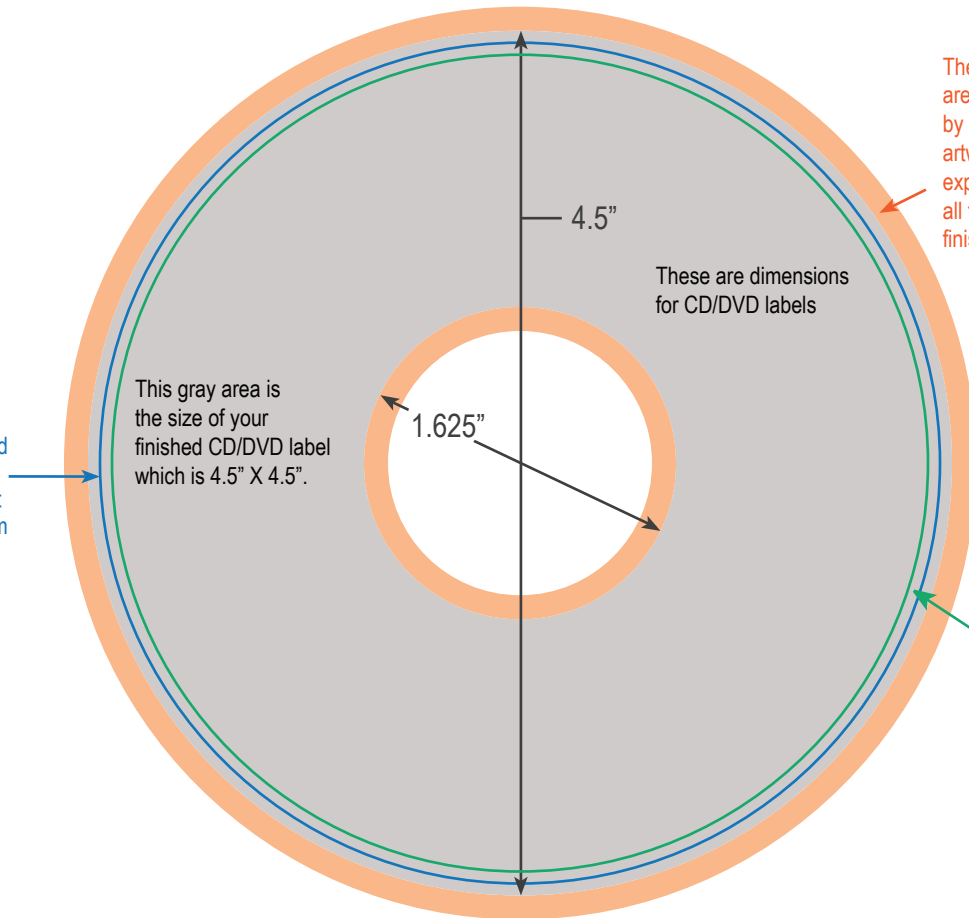


The blue line marks the "safe area". It is 1/16" inside the edge of your printed piece. You should never put any wording, logos, or other important art closer than 1/16" from the edge, or it may get trimmed.



This gray area is the size of your finished CD/DVD label which is 4.5" X 4.5".

These are dimensions for CD/DVD labels

The orange area is the bleed area. It overlaps the printed label by at least 1/8" on all sides. Your artwork should fill this area if you expect the printed artwork to go all the way to the edge of your finished piece.

The green line marks the "safe area" for borders. When adding a border to your artwork, it is essential that your safety margin be .25" from the trim line in order to maintain border consistency on all sides.
