## Booklet Mailing Guidelines

Booklets mailing at letter-sized postage rates may vary in size, but they must be rectangular with a Length to Height ratio between 1.3 and 2.5 . Minimum size is $3.5^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ and maximum is $6^{\prime \prime} \times 10.5^{\prime \prime}$. Booklets mailing at letter rates must be wafered sealed prior to mailing. Square booklets smaller than $6^{\prime \prime} \times 6$ " are subject to additional non-automated postage fees. Booklets larger than $6^{\prime \prime} \times 10.5$ " are subject to Flat Sized postage rates. The maximum size we offer is $12^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{\prime \prime}$.

Square booklets larger than $6 " \times 6 "$ mail at Flat rates and are not subject to additional fees.

The blue line marks the "safe area". It is $1 / 16$ " inside the edge of your printed envelope. You should never put any wording, logos, or other important art closer than $1 / 16$ " from the edge, or it may get trimmed.


Alternate Barcode Area: There is an alternate area for the postal barcode. If there is a horizontal space of at least $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, the barcode can go underneath the addressing info.
